- 1. Let me introduce you....
- 2. Our sacred texts assume connection/relationships.
- · The last act of creation was relationships.
- The English words 'one another' appear 50+ times in the New Testament.
- · Jesus prayed in John 17: "...that they may be one as We are one."
- · Paul compared members of the Church with parts of the human body as they connected with each other.
- · So...living life without relationships/connection is not good because it is not what God intends for us.
- The Harvard Study of Adult Development tracked 258 Harvard graduates for 75 years.

John Ortberg cites a study of 7,000 people over 9 years.
