WHEN THE FULNESS OF TIME CAME

Message Dec 30/31, 2017

Galatians 4:4-7 “When the fulness of time had come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the full rights as sons.”

1. There is time, and then there is time, and then...
2. The world was ready for the birth of Christ.
 - a. Culturally – common language(s)
 - b. Politically – ‘Roman Peace’
 - c. Geographically – extensive road system
 - d. Spiritually – former religions were floundering
3. At just the right time, which means His time, God acted in Jesus Christ.
4. God was, and is, an on-time God.

5. What time is it in your world?

a. New Year’s Eve can be a time of reflection and resolution

(Calories, Cash, Cleaning, Career)

b. We don’t find time – we make it.

c. Do we need to ‘prepare Him room’ in the new year as well?


