"Is prayer your steering wheel or your spare tire?"

I. PRAYING EFFECTIVE PRAYERS

A. Prayer is a vital key that <u>c</u> us with our heavenly Father.

B. Prayer is both a <u>p</u> and an awesome

<u>r_____</u>

C. Biblical prayer is crying to God out of our <u>c</u> it is the pouring out of our <u>s</u> before God.

D. True prayer happens when our \underline{w} is aligned with the \underline{w} of God, and we pray accordingly.

"The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working." (James 5:16)

II. WE TEND TO RESIST PRAYING FOR WHAT WE PERCEIVE TO BE IMPOSSIBLE.

A. The problem is that we rest the power of prayer too much upon <u>o</u>.

B. We are to see ourselves as <u>i</u> in the Lord's hands for accomplishing his purposes through prayer.

"Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God." (Romans 8) C. Prayer is an act of <u>o</u> and <u>p</u> for the believer.

D. We are <u>c</u> to pray. But we are also <u>i</u> to bring our needs before the Lord.

E. We are to anchor ourselves in his <u>f</u> and promises.

III. 5 KEY COMPONENTS OF EFFECTIVE PRAYER

- A. Pray <u>r</u> pray for things that are on God's heart.
- B. Pray with <u>c</u> pray knowing that God will listen and answer prayer according to His good will.
- C. Pray continuously be <u>p</u> in prayer.
- D. God <u>a</u> in His time God assures us that he will answer our prayers in his perfect timing.
- E. God answers for His <u>g</u> God gets all of it, no matter our prayers or how He answers them.

"We tend to use prayer as a last resort, but God wants it to be our first line of defense. We pray when there's nothing else we can do, but God wants us to pray before we do anything at all. Most of us would prefer, however, to spend our time doing something that will get immediate results. We don't want to wait for God to resolve matters in His good time because His idea of 'good time' is seldom in sync with ours." — Oswald Chambers
