LSA STATE CROSS COUNTRY MEET

Congratulations to our 5 Cross Country runners who ran in the State Cross Country meet held in Bloomington, IL last Saturday. All of the kids did a great job and represented Immanuel Lutheran School in a grand fashion. The weather was beautiful and our runners did great! This is a big, intimidating, fast race and our runners had a great experience. The girls ran the 2 mile race first and did great! Ashton finished in 61st place overall with a time of 15:50:78, Ali finished in 63rd place overall with a time of 15:53:28, and Izzy finished in 97th place overall with a time of 17:36:88. Next, the boys ran the 2 mile race as well. Aiden finished in 26th place overall with a time of 12:59:13 and Luke finished in 139th place with a time of 17:56:68. In order to move on to nationals next Saturday in Mequon, WI, the runner has to finish in the top seven 6th grade and below at the state meet. Aiden got 5th place for 6th grade and under! He is excited to participate at the national meet next weekend in Mequon, Wisc.
