FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

Need Based Aide - The financial aid process is completed online in a confidential manner through Smart Tuition Aide. A link to the application may be found on your Smart Tuition account page. Application must be turned in ASAP.

Referral Program - Immanuel offers a discount to families who help us boost our enrollment. A current family will receive a \$1,000 tuition credit for a newly enrolled full-time student they refer. The applying family must name the referring family in the application process. (Little Ark receives a \$500 credit.)

Kindergarten, First & Second Grade Tuition Program — A \$500 tuition credit will be awarded for each year a student attends Little Ark 3 year old, 4 year old and/or Kindergarten Prep (maximum credit of \$1,500.00) This credit will be applied evenly towards that student's Kindergarten, first and second grade tuition at Immanuel Lutheran School.
